Ansan | Nami Island | Everland | Jeju Island

Day 1: Arrival in Incheon - Ansan - Gyeonggi

Upon arrival at Incheon International Airport, you will be greeted and transferred to Songdo Island. Songdo is a new smart city and embodies the future of Incheon. Built on a reclaimed land, Songdo offers a number of attractions. Stop for photos at G Tower Observatory, one of the landmark buildings in Songdo. There is a Sky Garden which is open to visitors in the day. Here you will be able to see Songdo in its entirety and enjoy a bicycle rental service for free. Continue to Sihwa Embankment, a popular spot for leisure activities and sports. After that, you will be taken to Oido Island, an island on the West Coast region of South Korea's Gyeonggi Province. During Autumn, you will visit Ansan Reed Marsh. After a stop at Ansan Muslim Mosque for prayer, you will visit Ansan Multicultural Food Street and Ansan Starlight Village. Transfer to the hotel for check in. Overnight in Gyeonggi.

Day 2: Gyeonggi - Everland - Seoul

B/L/D

After breakfast and check out from the hotel, enjoy your full day of fun at Everland. After that, you will return to Seoul and stop for prayer at Itaewon Mosque. Then, enjoy one of the shows (Painters, BiBob or Fantastic). Transfer to the hotel for check in. Overnight in Seoul.

Day 3: Seoul - Nami Island - Seoul

After breakfast at the hotel, visit Nami Island, the shooting location for the evergreen drama "Winter Sonata" via Bukhangang river road. This tiny half-moon shaped island is located in Chuncheon, Gangwon Province. You will meet a forest of verdant trees holding up the sky and open grassy areas where ostriches, rabbits, chipmunks, ducks and peacocks warmly welcome visitors in the midst of wild flowers. Then, enjoy the view of Chuncheon from the Chuncheon Skywalk. The skywalk has gained attention as the new popular attraction at Chuncheon's Uiamho Lake. The observation deck with a scenic view is located halfway along the bike path and it is a great spot to take pictures. Next, stop for photos at a major natural landmark in Gapyeong-gun, Gyeonggi-do Yongchu Waterfall. Return to the hotel and overnight in Seoul.

Day 4: Seoul - Jeju

After breakfast at the hotel and check out, transfer to Gimpo Airport for your departing flight to Jeju. Upon arrival in Jeju, you will be greeted and transferred to the Mysterious Road. Also known as 'Goblin Road', Mysterious Road is famous for the optical illusion that makes it appears to be sloping upwards, when in fact it runs downhill. Then, visit the Dragon Head Rock. Situated at the north of Jeju City, it was created by the strong winds and waves over thousands of years. Then, visit the Teddy Bear Museum, one of Korea's main tourist attractions. Although many teddy bear museums can be found internationally, the Teddy Bear Museum in Jeju Island is one of the few teddy museums found in Korea that boasts a unique collection of teddy bears to entertain its visitors. Next, visit a spectacular volcanic rock formation at the southern coast of Jeju Island, Jusangjeolli Cliff. After that, stop at Cheonjiyon Waterfall for photos and visit Green Tea Museum. After dinner, transfer to the hotel and check in. Overnight in Jeju Island.





Day 5: Jeju Island B/L/D

After breakfast and check out from the hotel, start your tour with a visit to an ecology and cultural resort, Ilchul Land. It is a well-known as the shooting location for the popular Korean shows, including 'Running Man' and the drama of 'What Star Do You Come From'. Then, visit the Seongeup Folk Village, a small town that holds a vast amount of culture. Continue to Seoangsan Sun Rise Peak which rose from under the sea in a volcanic eruption over 100,000 years ago. Located on the eastern end of Jeju Island, there is a huge crater at the top of the peak. The crater is about 600m in diameter and 90m high. With 99 sharp rocks surrounding the crater, it looks like a gigantic crown. Later on, visit Seopjikoji, which is located at the end of the eastern shore of Jeju Island. "Seopji" is the old name for the area, and "Koji" is Jeju dialect meaning a sudden bump on the land. Stop for photos at the Jongdari Beach Road. After shopping at Dongmun Traditional Market, transfer to the airport for your departing flight to Seoul. Upon arrival at Gimpo Airport, transfer to the hotel for check in. Overnight in Seoul.

Day 6: Seoul

After breakfast at the hotel, start your day with a visit to Gyeongbok Palace, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. After that, enjoy shopping for local products at the Gwanghwamun Plaza, Pine Tree Center, Ginseng Store, Amethyst Factory, Cosmetic Store, Ginseng Outlet and Duty Free Shop. Then, you are free to shopping at Myeongdong Street. After dinner, return to the the hotel and overnight in Seoul.

Day 7: Seoul

After breakfast and check out from the hotel, you are free at leisure. Then, you will be transferred to the airport for your departure flight.


