With an area of 6,930 sq m, the main body of the building is a five-floor structure and the central tower is eleven-floor high.</p>	45	40

Tour 1330 - 1730 <i>Push-Car Ride, Wulai Waterfall, Aborigine Folk dance Show, Swallow Lake (Passby), Chieftain Statue</i></p> <p>Wulai is a famous mountain village in northern Taiwan and is located in water reservation area. It was the prime hunting ground for the Atayal tribe a long time ago. The town's name means boiling water in the Atayal language, referring to its abundance of hot springs recreation.</p>	55	45
HC	<input type="checkbox"/> <p>Taipei Night Tour (3 Hrs) Pick-up 17:30 <i>Din Tai Fung Restaurant Dinner : Steamed Dumplings (xiaolongbao), Longshan Temple, Huaxi Street Night Market, Taipei 101 Building(entrance to observatory NOT included)</i></p> <p>Longshan (Dragon Mountain) Temple is the oldest and most famous. It is also one of Taiwan's finest examples of temple architecture. Taipei 101 located in Xin-Yi district, East of Taipei, is 509m in height. The tower has the world's fastest elevators (doubledecker) where it can go as fast as 63 km/h. The indoor observation deck is on the 89th floor (382m).</p>	55	55
HD	<input type="checkbox"/> <p>Nothern Coast Tour (4 Hrs) Pick-up 08:00 <i>Keelung City, Keelung Harbour, Buddha Statue, Yehliu Park, Queen's Head</i></p> <p>The Queen's Head is one of the most famous scenes in Yehliu Geopark. It is a kind of mushroom rock formed due to the differential erosion caused by seawater during crust movement. It is estimated that the age of the rock is about 4,000 years old. The so called 'Queen's Head' is because the shape as formed after the top of rock being fallen apart in 1962~1963 appears like the side face of Queen Elizabeth.</p>	45	35
