TENTATIVE ITINERARY

Day 1 PARIS

Make your own way to hotel and meet & greet with welcome drink at hotel. Check in at 4pm. The rest of the evening at own leisure

Day 2 PARIS - LONGYEARBYEN, SPITSBERGEN (MOB/D)

(4hr 30mins flight) Breakfast on own expense. Group transfer to the airport terminal, check-in of flight selected by PONANT. Longyearbyen is the capital of the Norwegian Svalbard archipelago, located on Svalbard's main island, and is the northernmost territorial capital on the planet. (temp -40C) The glaciers, the mountains stretching as far as the eye can see and the untouched nature. Embarkation from 4pm to 5pm

Day 3 HORNSUND (B/L/D)

Nestling between millennial glaciers and carved mountains, and considered to be "the crown of Arctic Norway", Spitsbergen is a place that never sees the night. Your ship will take you closer to this fascinating archipelago and, more particularly, the Hornsund fjord. Its the most stunning: at the end of its vast bay, 8 great glaciers slowly make their way down to the sea.

Day 4 - 5 AT SEA (B/L/D)

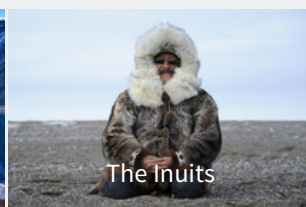

Day 5 JAN MAYEN ISLAND, SVALBARD (B/L/D)

The island of Jan Mayen, which belongs to Norway, lies hidden off the coast of Greenland, lost between the Arctic The Arctic Ocean and the North Atlantic. Tongues of ice descend from its volcanic summit, which 2,227 metres culminates and is covered with a thick glacial mantle.

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TENTATIVE ITINERARY

Day 6 AT SEA (B/L/D)

During your journey at sea, make the most of the many services and activities on board. As for lovers of the open sea, they will be able to visit the ship's upper deck to admire the spectacle of the waves and perhaps be lucky enough to observe marine species.

Day 7-8 ITTOQQORTOORMIIT REGION (B/L/D)

in the Ittoqqortoormiit region, you will have the rare opportunity of immersing yourself in the heart of isolated scenery and exploring the beauty of its landscapes. The high alpine mountains stand out in the sky, revealing dark rock edges. The region is home to the longest fjord system in the world, Scoresby Sound. On the edge of the fjord, the eponymous village is considered one of the most remote inhabited places in the world

Day 9 BLOSSEVILLE COAST (B/L/D)

Aboard your ship, follow in the footsteps of Jules Poret de Blosseville, a French explorer and sailor as he set off to discover this isolated and unexplored part of eastern Greenland and gave French names to various sites on the coast

Day 10-11 AMMASSALIK REGION - AT SEA (B/L/D)

Still almost unknown just a century ago, the east coast of Greenland remains the most authentic and majestic region. Here, the alpine mountains merge intimately with the sea, while the fjords are adorned with high snow-capped peaks and drifting icebergs. Follow in the wake of Captain Jean-Baptiste Charcot's famous ship, the Pourquoi Pas?, which set off with its crew to discover Ammassalik, a small island of primitive and wild beauty where the Inuit people chose to live

Day 12 PRINS CHRISTIAN SUND & AUGPILATOK (B/L/D)

Your ship glides silently towards the Greenland coast, in a setting punctuated by pointed peaks and majestic glaciers... You are on the verge of crossing the Prins Christian Sund, a narrow channel that stretches out and zigzags over some one hundred kilometres between Greenland's south-east and south-west

Day 12 PRINS CHRISTIAN SUND & AUGPILATOK (B/L/D)

Visit Aappilattoq (Augpilatok), is a small Inuit village of around one hundred inhabitants, whose name means "sea anemone" in Greenlandic. Located in a mountainous region inaccessible by road, its picturesque, colourful houses stretch out to the southern tip of Greenland,

Day 13 IGALIKU & NARSAQ FJORD (B/L/D)

Discover the small village of Igaliku, famous for having been the episcopal seat during the Viking period and the town of Narsaq, surrounded by icebergs. Dominated by lush mountains, this small town is typical of Greenland.

Day 14 AT SEA

Day 15 EVIGHEDSFJORDEN (B/L/D)

Your ship glides slowly along the water towards the west coast of Greenland, to enter Evighedsfjorden, which means "the fjord of Eternity", and for good reason: just when you think you've reached the end of this stretch of sea measuring over 100 kilometres in length, it seems to go on forever, as though to bring even more pleasure to those sailing in it. The spectacular scenery ranges from glaciers to tundra with an abundant flora, and jagged cliffs

Day 16 KANGERLUSSUAQ - PARIS (B)

Disembarkation at 7.00am through the ice, you will reach the starting The town of Kangerlussuaq in Greenland was point of the very first crossing of the Greenland ice home to an American military base. Nowadays, cap, led in 1888 by Fridtjof Nansen, the great thanks to its international airport, it has become Norwegian polar explorer. a transit point for travellers seeking adventure in the Far North. Flight to Paris (5hr 20mins). Meet & greet at the airport and transfer to the hotel.

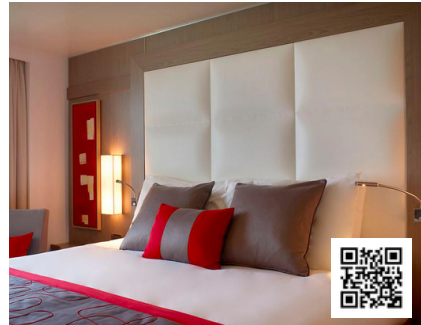
