ACCESSIBLE STATEROOMS

Our fully accessible staterooms are designed for use by guests with highly limited or no mobility who require regular use of a mobility device, and provide accessible elements including turning space, accessible routes throughout the cabin, and accessible bathrooms. Ambulatory Accessible rooms are also available. Staterooms range from approximately 237 to 624 square feet based on stateroom category.



Note: Floor plans, amenities, stateroom images and diagrams represent typical arrangements and may vary by ship. Certain stateroom categories may vary in size and configuration by ship. Square footage varies based on stateroom category and deck location. Stateroom views are considered unobstructed unless noted otherwise. Some categories have portholes versus picture windows. Some staterooms are partially to fully obstructed, as shown on deck plans. Obstructions do not include certain nautical items like handrails, dividers or ship hardware. For balcony staterooms, the view is determined from the perspective of the balcony railing. Balconies may have either solid steel or glass railings. Upper berth and bed ladder capacities are 250 lbs. Staterooms that can accommodate rollaways have two lower berths and one upper berth, and the staterooms can accommodate a fourth berth as a rollaway bed upon request at time of reservation. There are a limited number of rollaway beds per ship, per voyage. Use of rollaway beds restricts cabin space.
