**DAY 1 WELCOME TO HALIFAX**

Arrive in Halifax, your quintessential maritime destination. You'll be picked up from Halifax International Airport and taken to your downtown hotel.

**DAY 9 THE TIDES OF HOPEWELL ROCKS**

Cruise the waters of Shediac Bay aboard a private lobster boat (weather permitting) and get a glimpse into the fascinating world of these sea creatures, as well as the lobster industry.

*You'll also indulge in a delicious seafood Highlight Lunch with wine.*

Travel on to Hopewell Rocks on the shores of the bay, before arriving in the exciting city of Moncton. (B) (LW)
