# GLACIER & BERNINA EXPRESS

5 DAYS / 4 NIGHTS CHUR – (TIRANO) – BRIG – (ZERMATT) – BRIG

The combination of the two most popular express journeys in Switzerland, spiced up with a spectacular excursion to Zermatt and the Gornergrat. A blend of awe-inspiring glaciers and dramatic alpine peaks, the ultimate taster package combination. The journey starts in the historic market town of Chur, the oldest town in Switzerland: the Bernina as well as the Glacier Express have their starting point here.

## DAY 1 – ARRIVAL IN CHUR

Transfer by train to Chur. If time allows a guided tour of the historic city centre comes highly recommended. Discover 5000 years of history in 2 hours with the free audio guide which can be downloaded in advance from the Chur Tourism website. Overnight in Chur.

## DAY 2 – BERNINA EXPRESS EXCURSION

Return journey on the Bernina Express to Tirano. The legendary railway line has been declared a UNESCO world heritage site. The spectacular track with the world-renowned viaducts combines seamlessly with the pristine mountain landscape, creating the perfect balance between beautiful nature and ingenious engineering. Once you arrive in Tirano there is about an hour leisure time to explore or for a quick lunch before you travel back. Overnight in Chur.

## DAY 3 – GLACIER EXPRESS FROM CHUR TO BRIG

A fascinating rail journey on the

slowest express train in the world, with unrivalled views on the 4½ hour journey from Chur to Brig. Through the impressive Rhine gorge, over the Oberalp pass (2,033m/6,670ft) and along the deep valley of the Rhône, the Glacier Express travels through an incredibly fascinating and impressive part of the Alps. Arrive in Brig in the afternoon which leaves time to explore the lovely old town with stately houses and cosy inns or visit the baroque Stockalper palace. Overnight in Brig.

## DAY 4 – ZERMATT & GORNERGRAT

The world famous resort is located at the foot of the Matterhorn and can only be reached by train. The excursion to the Gornergrat is one of the most popular and truly spectacular experiences in Switzerland. The platform on the Gornergrat offers the best view towards the Matterhorn and the surrounding alpine peaks. Overnight in Brig.

## DAY 5 – DEPARTURE

Rail transfer to Zürich and return journey home.

From Geneva the train glides swiftly along the shores of the lake to Montreux, from where you take your seat in the carriage of the Golden Pass train to Interlaken. Visit the famous Jungfrauoch, travel to Brig to change for the iconic Glacier Express. The final trip on the Bernina Express to Tirano in Italy and back is the icing of the cake.

## DAY 1 – ARRIVAL IN MONTREUX

Rail transfer from Geneva to Montreux. Overnight in Montreux.

## DAY 2 – LAKE GENEVA – CHÂTEAU DE CHILLON – ROCHERS-DE-NAYE

Montreux is the heart of the Swiss Riviera. Visit the famous Château de Chillon before you travel on the cog railway to the peak of Rochers-de-Naye with its unique panorama over Lake Geneva and the Alps. From November until December 24th you can visit the real Santa Claus in his grotto perched atop the mountain.

## DAY 3 – GOLDEN PASS

Board the Golden Pass train from Montreux and relax as the train sweeps through the many vineyards and country estates on its way to Interlaken. Picturesque villages and panoramic views are sure to impress you.

## DAY 4 – FREE DAY IN THE JUNGFRAU REGION

Interlaken sits in the heart of the Bernese Oberland and the Swiss Alps. Explore this popular resort

which is nestled between the two beautiful lakes of Thun and Brienz inviting you to a cruise accompanied by stunning views. Overnight in Interlaken.

## DAY 5 – EXCURSION TO JUNGFRAUJOCH

No visit to the Jungfrau Region is complete without a visit to the Jungfrauoch, the highest railway station in Europe. Enjoy the breath-taking views of the Aletsch glacier, the longest in the Alps and a UNESCO World Heritage site. Overnight in Interlaken.

## DAY 6 – GLACIER EXPRESS

Depart Interlaken by train to Brig where you will join the Glacier Express to St. Moritz taking in dramatic landscapes along your journey. Overnight in St. Moritz.

## DAY 7 – BERNINA EXPRESS

Today you will join the Bernina Express. Pass mighty glaciers and over the highest point at 2,253m (7,391ft) down to the palm trees and Oleander of the mountain village of Tirano (Italy). Experience some of the exceptional local cuisine on offer

in the many cafés and restaurants before starting your return journey. Overnight in St. Moritz.

## DAY 8 – DEPARTURE

Rail transfer back to Zürich for your onward journey.



The world-famous Glacier Express takes you on an exciting panoramic ride to Chur. Along the Rhone Valley you travel through an incredibly fascinating part of the Alps. From Chur you travel in the afternoon to the border or a Swiss airport.

7 DAYS / 6 NIGHTS INTERLAKEN – JUNGFRAUJOCH – NIGHT SLEDGING – LUCERNE – TITLIS – SLEIGH RIDE

A leisurely tour to two of Switzerland's best known resorts. As popular in winter as in summer, the two lakeside resorts of Interlaken and Lucerne offer fantastic winter scenery and excursions for fun without skis. Explore high alpine peaks, Switzerland's traditional winter warmer – Cheese Fondue and enjoy a horse-drawn sleigh ride.

### DAY 1 – ARRIVAL IN INTERLAKEN

From Zürich airport via Bern to Interlaken. Afternoon at leisure. Overnight in Interlaken.

### DAY 2 – EXCURSION TO JUNGFRAUJOCH

Day excursion to the Jungfrauoch – Top of Europe. Impressive views of snow-capped peaks and the magnificent Aletsch Glacier. Overnight in Interlaken.

### DAY 3 – NIGHT SLEDGING & FONDUE

Day at leisure. Enjoy some of the beautiful winter walks around or join the free walking tour of Interlaken (Mon, Wed or Sat). In the early evening pick-up from your hotel by minibus. Travel from Interlaken high into the Swiss Alps, take in the starlit winter panorama before riding down the 1 hour sledge run. Along the way the trail winds through woods, crosses alpine meadows and passes majestic frozen waterfalls. The sledge run finishes at a small local restaurant for a traditional Swiss cheese fondue dinner. Overnight in Interlaken.

### DAY 4 – LUCERNE

Travel by train over the Brünig Pass, past Meiringen famous for its Meringue and the demise of Sherlock Holmes, towards picturesque Lucerne. Afternoon at leisure. Overnight in Lucerne.

### DAY 5 – FUN ON MOUNT TITLIS GLACIER

Snow and ice await you at the top of Mt. Titlis. Travel by train to the mountain resort of Engelberg. Take a leisurely stroll through the resort before taking the 3 sets of gondolas to the 3,020m high peak of Mount Titlis. Take the ice-flyer over the glacier's crevasses, have some fun with the snow toys in the Glacier park and walk the Titlis Cliff walk – Europe's highest suspension bridge. Overnight in Lucerne.

### DAY 6 – HORSE-DRAWN SLEIGH RIDE ON MOUNT RIGI

Journey by boat from Lucerne to Vitznau and by cogwheel train to Rigi Kaltbad. From here take a horse-drawn carriage or sleigh to Rigi First for a hearty Cheese Fondue at restaurant Bärenstube. On days when the horse-drawn

carriage is not operating travel to Rigi Kulm, collect your snow shoes and walk towards the Cheese Farm Chäserenholz for a Cheese Fondue before walking down to Rigi Staffel for your return journey to Lucerne.

### DAY 7 – DEPARTURE

Travel by train back to Zürich for your onward journey or return flight home.

# WINTER DISCOVERY

8 DAYS / 7 NIGHTS DAVOS – MONTREUX – NEUCHÂTEL – LA BRÉVINE – BERN

The dramatic mountain landscapes await on this remarkable tour of discovery across Switzerland. Journey from mountain hideaways high above a sophisticated lakeside resort to the coldest corner of Switzerland, this tour is a wintry combination of very different excursions and destinations. Explore the mystic valley also called 'The Siberia of Switzerland', follow in the footsteps of famous author Thomas Mann in Davos-Schatzalp and travel on Switzerland's most popular train – the Glacier Express.

## DAY 1 – ARRIVAL

From Zürich by train to Davos Platz. Ride the funicular to the top of Schatzalp mountain where your hotel is located at 1,861m. Afternoon to explore via the winter walking trails all around. Overnight Hotel Schatzalp.

## DAY 2 – HORSE-DRAWN SLEIGH RIDE

Descent by funicular or toboggan (small suppl.) to the highest town in Europe, Davos. Browse the many art galleries, cafés, and shops or head for the winter sports areas surrounding Davos. In the early afternoon enjoy a 1-hour horse-drawn sleigh ride in one of the magical valleys nearby. In the unlikely event of insufficient snow down in the valley the sleigh will be replaced with a horse-drawn carriage ride. Overnight Hotel Schatzalp.

## DAY 3 – SCENIC ROUTE TO LAKE GENEVA

The Glacier Express may not be the quickest route but certainly the most scenic with breath-taking views along the way. Overnight in Montreux.

## DAY 4 – WINTER FUN IN GSTAAD

Travel by Golden Pass train to the chalet town of Gstaad. Well known for its vast ski area the picture postcard winter sports resort is equally attractive to non-skiers, with its beautiful panoramic setting amidst the pristine alpine winter scenery. Soak up the atmosphere, go on one of the many winter walking trails or simply enjoy lunch in one of the excellent restaurants long established here. In the evening return to Montreux.

## DAY 5 – MONTREUX & NEUCHÂTEL

In the morning take time to explore Montreux with its serene lakeside promenade. In the afternoon board a train for the short transfer to Neuchâtel. Overnight in Neuchâtel.

## DAY 6 – THE SIBERIA OF SWITZERLAND

Not far from Neuchâtel you will find the mystical valley of La Brévine where temperatures in winter have been known to drop to -40°C! Warm up with a short winter walking trail (approx. 3km) which passes many typical farmhouses and the lake, Lac des

Tailleres. After braving the cold, pick-up your 'ice diploma' at one of the restaurants in the valley and indulge in some local specialities. Return and overnight in Neuchâtel.

## DAY 7 – MEDIEVAL BERN

After breakfast take a short rail transfer to Bern, Switzerland's capital. Easily explored on foot, the city centre feels like a step back in time with its cobbled streets, water fountains and 15th century buildings. Be sure to visit one of the cellar restaurants for an atmospheric dining experience. Overnight in Bern.

## DAY 8 – DEPARTURE

If your flight time allows do some last minute souvenir shopping in the quirky shops located in the 'Lauben' – Bern's covered walkways. Rail transfer to Zürich and return home or continue onward journey.

## DAY 1 – ARRIVE IN ENGELBERG

Arrival in Switzerland and onward travel by rail to Engelberg. Check in, and enjoy a first stroll round the village before settling back into the hotel.

## DAY 2 – EASY WINTER WALKING & EXPLORING

Take a cable-car ride up mount Brunni. This area is known as the 'sunny side' of Engelberg! Take a walk through the snowy landscape from Ristis to Brunni, from where you will enjoy great views of Mount Titlis and the alps. After a lunch on the mountain, take a cable-car back to Engelberg, and walk the few minutes to Engelberg's monastery. Here you will have a self-guided tour of the cheese factory, and you can visit the beautiful church belonging to the monastery.

## DAY 3 – SNOW & FUN ON MOUNT TITLIS

Today you will have an unforgettable trip to the top of Mount Titlis at 3,020 m by revolving cable-car. At the top,

you can explore the glacier cave, and experience the Titlis Cliff Walk – Europe's highest suspension bridge. After some time at the top, take the gondola down to the middle station, Trübsee, where you can visit the Igloo village. You can also try out skiing here, with a 1 hour beginner ski experience included. For a small supplement you might want to hire some snowtubes for some fun snowtubing or even get your first try on an e-snowmobile.

## DAY 4 – DEPARTURE

After breakfast it is time for your return journey.
