


Best of France





Day 1 | Bonjour Paris

Day 6 | Pilgrimage to Lourdes and on to Biarritz

Then, travel west to the Basque Coast, where we spend the night.

Day 7 | Venture to Bordeaux

Day 8 | Discover Beautiful Saint-Émilion



Lush green valleys and wine hills take centre stage today during a scenic half-day included excursion to Saint-Émilion, whose wine heritage dates back to Roman times. You will also have free time to explore Bordeaux and perhaps tease your taste buds with delicious Bordelaise cuisine or stroll through the city's historical centre admiring its beautiful architecture.
